The Department of Art and Art History is pleased to announce that Willamette University Senior Studio Art Major, Georgia Watson, has opened a remarkable exhibition of her recent work entitled, */Wax and Wane/*, in the Student Art Gallery on the second floor of the Art Building on the Willamette University campus, located at the corner of State and Winter Streets. The installation of encaustics (wax paintings) and interactive pieces are the culmination of the Lilly Project summer research grant (advised by Prof. James Thompson) that she received last Spring. The goal of her artistic research was to learn about the process of dying and perceptions of death through Hospice volunteer work. The artworks combine some of what she learned from terminally ill people and her ideas about maximizing life's potential. The exhibition runs through September 19th.
